IMPACT NEWS

Many of you attended the Nehemiah Action at U-Hall on March 22. A great big 'thank you' to all those of you who did - and brought others.

This is to summarize what happened there - and what has occurred since then on behalf of our neighbors.

Pre-Kindergarten Education -

First, IMPACT asked the City and County to commit to the target of 90% as the proportion of low-income children to be enrolled in publicly funded pre-K programs.

Second, IMPACT asked the City and County School Boards to commit to annual local reporting and publishing of achievement-gap data for low-income children at kindergarten and 3rd grade levels as soon as data are available to the School Boards.

Third, IMPACT asked the two School Board spokespeople to propose that the two School Divisions begin collaborative discussions about the phased expansion of pre-K services for low-income children.

All three requests were agreed to at the 3/22 meeting.

Since March 22 IMPACT has learned that:

> The CITY School Board is proposing adding two new pre-K classes next year for 3-year olds, in addition to the three existing classes for 3-year olds.

> The COUNTY has decided to restore full funding to the existing Bright Stars program which provides public pre-K classes for many 4-year olds. Whereas the program was to have been reduced to 11-month funding for critical staff, it has now been restored to funding for 12 months in the coming year.

We feel certain that the support of IMPACT's 33 communities of faith played an important role in bringing these steps about.

Interpretive Services -

IMPACT's ultimate goal is the creation and implementation of sustainable and comprehensive language access plans by City and County Police Departments and the Regional Jail - to meet the needs of our neighbors with limited proficiency in English.

> The Charlottesville PD now has a plan in place - and Chief Longo committed to recommending that the TJ Area Community Criminal Justice Board investigate a comprehensive LEP (limited English proficiency) for the regional jail system. Chief Longo will bring a progress report to IMPACT's October 2010 issues meeting.

> The Chief of the Albemarle County PD agreed to commit to create an LEP plan, to meet with IMPACT leaders periodically during the development process, and to provide a progress report at IMPACT's October meeting.
